Group size, age and individual registrations

We can accommodate groups of all sizes from 14 years old and up. Younger students can be accommodated if they stay with an older sibling or group leader. Individual registrations are possible only in our Summer Experience Program, June through August. Groups are classified by age generally as follows:

Youth: 14 to 19 years | Adult : 18 to 65 years | Senior : 60 years plus

Overview

Quest's group holiday programs provide participants with a unique learning holiday experience by combining ESL study with a variety of quality recreational activities. The program's goal goes beyond teaching English to include the expansion of horizons and the making of new friends. The program is highly customizable and can be organized year round, in winter, spring, summer or fall. The Quest Summer Experience Program (June through August) is the most popular with a great international mix of students.

Classes: 15 to 20 hours per week

Every student is tested for all language skills and placed appropriately in one of 10 levels. Small classes (maximum 9, July and August 16), led by professional, certified instructors, provide a comfortable environment in which to learn practical English. In addition, a solid text-book-based, communicative curriculum, combined with weekly review tests and detailed progress evaluations ensure a successful learning experience.

For youth summer groups arriving in June, July or August, the standard is 3 hours of classes per day. The option of 4 hours per day is available on request.

Accommodation: homestay, residence and private apartments

At Quest we understand the importance of quality accommodation to overall program success. That is why we manage our own accommodation service, regularly inspecting every accommodation to ensure comfort and satisfaction.

Homestay accommodation (one student per linguistic group guaranteed) is located within 45 minutes from the school by public transport. Residences (summer only) and apartments are generally within walking distance of the school. Accommodation is available in both single and double rooms and, if requested, groups can be divided between homestay and residence accommodation.

For every participant you will receive detailed accommodation information, including:

- Pictures (minimum 3 - building, host and room).
- Map indicating school and accommodation with directions.
- Video - Most profiles (not all) include a video clip of the host or accommodation.
- Detailed full page description of accommodation and amenities included.

Activities: exciting variety of activities everyday to suit every taste

The program offers a wide and exciting variety of activities designed to provide a truly Canadian experience and an opportunity to practice English conversational skills.

Both the type and order of activities are specially selected to meet each group's unique needs and to deliver the most satisfaction. The standard program includes an activity everyday (except one day during the week) including one full day excursion per weekend.

Specialized learning activities such as Tennis, Snowboarding and Sailing can also be arranged for groups and individuals.

All trips are by deluxe motor coach and include accommodation, in 3 or 4 star hotels, and tour guide. Meals and entrance fees for sightseeing are not included.

Tours can also be arranged for vacation only groups not taking any classes.

Transportation

Transportation to and from the airport is included in the program. Groups are greeted at the airport by school representatives who will provide them with their transit passes, emergency numbers card, transit map and information necessary prior their orientation on the first day school.

Transportation from accommodation to the school and during activities is normally by public transit. Transportation on excursions outside the city is by chartered bus.

All students are provided transportation maps and a detailed explanation on using the transportation system, which ranks as one of the safest and most efficient worldwide.

Safety and Service First

We take every measure to ensure the safety and comfort of students. Trained and experienced guides will be assigned to every group to ensure activities go smoothly. Multilingual school representatives will be available 24/7 to assist students with any help they may require. In addition, group leaders are provided with a free cell phone for emergency communications.

Pricing and Group Leaders

Pricing depends on group size, season and the options selected for accommodation and activities. Groups arriving in the off-peak season (peak season is June through August) can benefit from seasonal discounts.

Depending on group size, a number of group leaders can be accommodated free of charge. Additional group leaders can also be accommodated at reduced/cost rate.
