

# Self Placement Option

Take full control of your work placement. You will be entirely responsible for finding an appropriate work placement where you can further improve your English skills and gain valuable experience.

- ▶ Recommended level of English prior to starting internship: level 7 ↑/ 11.
- ▶ Work period must be between 8 and 48 weeks and cannot exceed the period of studies.
- ▶ No placement fee - only regular intensive course fees to pay.
- ▶ No interview / screening required.
- ▶ You can choose to work in any city in Canada.
- ▶ Must be 19 years of age or over.

## Registration Procedure (steps 2 to 3 not required for self placement option)

1. Take our on-line English test ([www.studyquest.net/quiz](http://www.studyquest.net/quiz)) to help determine how long you will need to study English and the total length of your program.
2. Submit the CPP application form - available online or through an agent.
3. Arrange for an online interview via Skype by emailing [internship@studyquest.net](mailto:internship@studyquest.net)
4. If your application is accepted, contact a Quest representative to register.
5. Pay your fees or required deposit.
6. Quest will issue your letter of acceptance which you can use to apply for your study permit and work permit.

## Overview

The Career Pathway Programs (CPP) provide students with the unique opportunity to study English and gain valuable experience in an English speaking work environment that will improve their English and enhance their career opportunities.

Students are placed with established Canadian and international companies based on their educational background, work experience and career objectives. Various fields (see back page) are available. Students are monitored throughout the entire program to ensure a successful experience.

## Visa Requirements

Applicants for the Business and Advantage CPP programs must obtain a study permit (regardless of the duration of study) and then a work permit. The work permit may be obtained in Canada or the home country.

For Working Holiday CPP applicants, please see visa requirements under program heading.

## English Requirements

All students are required to meet minimum language proficiency requirements prior to starting their internship, including an exit test to ensure they can function effectively using English in the workplace.

Quest offers 11 levels of English and each level takes approximately 4 to 5 weeks to complete. Students must take this into consideration when deciding on the duration of their program.

In addition to their regular English studies, all CPP students are provided special workshops to ensure their work experience is successful. Workshops include:

- ▶ Resume Workshop: developing an effective resume in English.
- ▶ Presentation Workshop: developing effective interview skills.
- ▶ Cultural Workshop: understanding and operating in the Canadian work environment.



## Business Internship CPP (paid work placement)

An ideal program for graduating, new graduates or professionals seeking to improve their English skills and enhance their career opportunities.

- ▶ Duration: Minimum 4 months to maximum 24 months. 50% of the program must involve Intensive (25 hours per week) English study. The minimum work period is 2 months and cannot exceed the duration of studies.
- ▶ Course requirements: Students seeking positions in business or hospitality related fields must complete at minimum 4 weeks of the Business English or Hospitality program after reaching level 7.
- ▶ Level requirement by start of internship: Level 8 ↑/11. Exit test required.
- ▶ Fees: Program fees plus placement fee.

- ▶ Placement fee: \$1200.00. Some specialized fields require \$2000.00\*. See note and fields marked \* on back cover.



## Advantage CPP (unpaid/volunteer work placement)

Although this program is unpaid, it provides students with the best opportunity and flexibility in terms of job placement. It is an especially attractive program for students looking for short to medium term internships providing valuable English practice in a professional work environment. In addition to private firms, opportunities are also available with voluntary non-profit organizations.

- ▶ Duration: Minimum 2 months to maximum 6 months. 50% of the program must involve Intensive (25 hours per week) English study. The minimum work period is 1 month and cannot exceed the duration of studies.
- ▶ Fees: Regular course fees (25 hours per week) plus placement fee.
- ▶ Placement fee: \$1000.00.
- ▶ Level requirement by start of internship: Level 7 ↑/11. Exit test required.

## Working Holiday CPP (paid work placement)

This program is specifically designed for Working Holiday Visa holders. In addition to developing English skills and job placement, students are provided with support throughout their entire time in Canada. During their internship, students may continue to use school facilities and equipment, attend activities and seek general counselling as needed.

Those wishing to obtain a Working Holiday Visa are subject to age requirements and must be a citizen of one of the following countries:

Australia, Belgium, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Korea (Republic of), Latvia, Lithuania, Mexico, New Zealand, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Taiwan, United Kingdom.

Visas are normally released once per year and should be applied for well in advance. Contact the Canadian embassy in your country for details and application forms.

- ▶ Duration: Minimum 2 months to maximum 12 months. Minimum 4 weeks intensive (25 hours per week) English study required.
- ▶ Fees: Regular course fees (25 hours per week) plus placement fee.
- ▶ Placement fee: \$1200.00. Study 12 weeks or longer: \$750.00 (some fields require \$2000.00\*)
- ▶ Level requirement by start of internship: Level 7 ↑/11. Exit test required.

All CPP applicants must read and agree to the CPP policies available on our website or on request. By registering in the program acceptance is given by default.
